Sedalia Country Club

The Sedalia Country Club is a family-oriented, private community established by a few distinguished Sedalia residents in 1906. The club's rich traditions of excellence, respectfulness, and integrity surround family and community, and we strive to offer the best services and amenities for our members and guests. The challenging golf course, family-friendly pool, and excellent dining facilities are sure to enrich family experiences and treasured friendships for a lifetime of pleasure and cherished memories. Members are sure to enjoy both the setting and community of the Sedalia Country Club no matter the occasion.

Mission Statement

Since 1906, the mission of the Sedalia Country Club has been to provide a high quality golf and social experience for our members, their families, and guests. By providing the best services, amenities, and staff, Sedalia Country Club creates a fun, family-friendly environment.

History

In the year of 1903, the State Fair Board gave certain Sedalia residents the right to build a golf course on the Missouri State Fair Grounds. Nearly two years later, June 3, 1905, the Sedalia Country Club was formed. There were 67 regular members admitted into the Club.

The next year, the Club purchased a block of ground adjoining the Missouri State Fair Grounds on the east and facing Limit Avenue. On March 22, 1906, the Sedalia Country Club became a corporation. A club house was built costing \$4,200, which was completed and opened in June 1906. By then, the regular membership grew to 88.

In 1907, sixty acres were purchased and a nine hole golf course was laid out.

While the Club upheld its high standards as a golf club, it was the scene for many social functions, outstanding parties for the members and entertaining honored guests, such as the formal reception and dinner given in honor of President Taft in 1911.

Since 1909, the old club was remodeled and redecorated several times, adding locker and shower rooms, golf shop, and the building of a swimming pool.

A tornado on May 4, 1977 destroyed the club house, swimming pool, tennis courts, and other club facilities that were located on South Limit Avenue. In the months following the tornado, many proposals were given as to the outcome of what would happen to Sedalia Country Club. In July, the proposal of the purchase of Walnut Hills Country Club was passed.

On August 22, 1977, the Sedalia Country Club purchased Walnut Hills Country Club, which included the Surf Club, tennis courts, and golf course. Many renovations have been

made during the years such as the restructuring of the pool, an addition of new kitchen facilities, enlarging the dining area, and redesigning the course.

One of the more interesting aspects of the Sedalia Country Club is the presence of a small graveyard which has burial markers with dates before the Civil War. Considered in the rough between the 10th, 11th, and 18th fairways, the Shobe-Jamison-Quisenberry Cemetery is the final resting place of members of some of Pettis County's oldest families that were buried there between 1859 and 1921.

Club House

The club house was built as a part of the Walnut Hills Country Club and was part of the SCC purchase of Walnut Hills Country Club in 1977. Since 1977, many renovations have been made. Our latest renovation was the women's locker room in early 2016.



Hours and Contact Information

The SCC Club House is closed on most Mondays, but is open the rest of the week. The office is open Tuesday through Friday 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM.

Attire

Country club casual attire is preferred; however, proper denim is allowed. Clothes should be neat in appearance and shirt tails should be tucked in. Please, no short shorts, cargo shorts or pants, cut offs, gym shorts, halter tops, or frayed clothing.

Minimums

Each membership classification has a required dining minimum that must be spent each month. Members spending dates are as follows:

- A through F** 11th through 10th
- G through N** 18th through 17th
- O through Z**..... 25th through the 24th

The first date is when the minimums will start and the second date is when the cycle ends the following month.

Guests

Guests are almost always welcome to the Club House as long as they are accompanied by a member. A dining guest’s bill may be applied against the member’s monthly minimum. Please note that other areas of SCC, such as the Surf Club, have different guest policies.

Dining

The Sedalia Country Club has an exceptional dining room where all meals are served. SCC offers a wide variety of food choices ranging from Alaskan King Crab Legs to a Mexican Buffet. We guarantee your taste buds will be satisfied. We also offer a kid’s menu.

Lunch is served from 11 am to 2 pm, and dinner is served from 6 pm to 9 pm. Reservations are requested for all dining services. To make a reservation, call the office at (660)826-2044.

Most food purchases count against the monthly minimum. The only food exception is carryout which does not count against the minimum. Beverages do not count against this

minimum, either. Also, a 10 percent gratuity is added to the menu prices for your server, as well as a 5 percent house cover.

Ben Kempton was hired to our catering team in May of 2017 as Chef de Cuisine. Ben was born and raised in Sedalia, but has travelled all over the world learning the trade. His favorite things to cook with are fresh, local produce and high-quality meats.

Bar

Another great asset to SCC is the upper and lower bars. Whether you want to enjoy a few drinks with friends or grab an “adult” refreshment on a hot day of golf, the bar has you covered! The upper bar is open late, so stop on by.

Golf Course Hours and Contact Information

The golf course is closed on Mondays until 1 PM. Similar to the Club House, there are some exceptions.

Golf Shop

Our golf shop offers a wide selection of golf attire and golf equipment for both men and women. Our courteous staff is ready to assist you!

The Golf Pro Shop hours vary depending on the season. From April to October, the shop is open 8 AM to 7 PM every day, but is closed on Mondays. From November to March, the shop is open 10 AM to dusk on Tuesdays through Fridays and 9 AM to dusk on Saturdays and Sundays.

Attire

Proper golf attire is required on the golf course and practice range at all times.

Driving Range

The driving range hours of operation will fluctuate with the hours of daylight. It will open when the Golf Shop opens and close at dusk. On Sundays the driving range will close 2 hours before dark to clean pick for mowing. Balls will be set-up at all times during the golf

season. Members who pay an annual range membership fee to hit unlimited range balls may do so without coming into the Golf Shop. Those members who do not have a season range membership must come to the Golf Shop and sign a ticket for range balls. Those who do not have season range members will be charged a fee of \$9 per hour. Annual range memberships are as follows:

Bag Storage

Let the Golf Shop take care of your golf clubs. Your clubs are set out for play prior to each round and are cleaned when you are finished. This service is available for a nominal fee of \$75 annually. Inquire at the Golf Shop.

Golf Handicaps

We will be using GHIN for our handicap service in 2017. If you have had a handicap in the past, you will be automatically placed in the system. There is a \$21 fee for an annual

handicap and will be billed on your club account. If you have any questions, please call Jaron in the Golf Shop.

Tee Times

Tee times are required on weekends, holidays, and days set aside for tournament practice rounds. Tee times are not required on weekdays, but players with tee times are given precedence over those with no reservations. Tee times may be arranged by calling the Golf Shop at (660)826-2230 no more than 2 weeks in advance.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are available for men, women, and juniors. Our golf staff will be happy to schedule your private lessons by calling or coming by the Golf Shop

Junior Golf Program

The Sedalia Country Club golf staff provides a junior golf academy each summer. Our staff provides the juniors with instruction covering the entire golf swing. The program also includes competitions, play days, and awards. Our Professionals take the juniors out on the course and cover golf course care, proper etiquette, and rules. The summer program is concluded with an awards pool party. Please pick up a Junior Golf Packet from the Golf Shop.



Golf Outings

If you are considering a company golf tournament or a charitable golf event, all requests must be submitted prior to January 15 and must be approved by the Board of Directors. Please contact Jaron for an application if you desire to hold such an event.

Guests

Guests are allowed on the SCC course, but must follow all SCC policies and guidelines. The guest fees are as follows:

House/Family Guest.....	\$25 (18 Holes)	\$12.50 (9 Holes)
Accompanied Guest.....	\$40 (18 Holes)	\$25 (9 Holes)
Unaccompanied Guest.....	\$60 (18 Holes)	\$40 (9 Holes)

In order to qualify for the \$40 rate, the guest(s) must be accompanied on the golf course by a member.

Each In-County Guest is restricted to three rounds per year.

*All fees include a one hour range session

Any member bringing an allowable guest to play on a Monday must sign a guest fee ticket prior to that day.

Trail Fees

All private golf car owners are required to pay an annual "trail fee". This fee is billed in March and must be paid before the use of a private golf car is permitted on the course. The fee for 2017 is \$350.

Policies and Guidelines

1. All guests must be registered with the Golf Shop prior to play.
2. All play is to begin on hole #1 unless authorized by the Golf Shop.
3. Proper golf attire is required on the golf course and practice range at all times.
4. Groups are limited to 5 players or less.
5. Each player must have a bag and clubs.
6. No more than 2 persons and 2 sets of clubs shall ride on a cart unless authorized by the Golf Shop.
7. Please keep golf cars at least 35 feet from the greens and tees.
8. Please observe signage on #1 and #10 tees for the golf cart restrictions for that day.

9. Repair all ball marks on the greens.
10. No play is allowed until 1 PM on Monday unless otherwise authorized by the Golf Professional Staff
11. Tuesday mornings during the golf season are reserved for Ladies Day, men may not tee off before 12 noon.
12. Junior Play will be regulated by the Golf Professional Staff.

Surf Club

The Surf Club was part of the 1977 purchase of Walnut Hills Country Club. Since the purchase, many renovations have been made. The Surf Club provides SCC families and guests an enjoyable and relaxing pool environment to cool down on a hot summer day.



Hours and Contact Information

The SCC Surf Club opens Memorial Day weekend and closes Labor Day weekend. The typical hours are 11 AM to 7 PM. Sundays beginning in June, the Surf Club will host night swim, meaning the pool will stay open later. If inclement weather should occur, the Surf Club may close early depending on the manager's discretion.

Connie Delph is one of the pool managers, and you can catch her at the pool just about every day. Darrin Christian is another manager, and he takes care of the pool house. He can answer any question you may have about the Surf Club. The phone number for the Surf Club is (660)826-8424.

Pool Snack Bar

The Surf Club offers a delicious pool snack bar with the best summer treats. Members have the option of charging the food bill to their accounts or paying with cash or credit card. However, families with only a Surf Club membership may only pay with cash or credit card.

Guests

Mondays are designated guest days. Members may bring guests on Mondays for \$5 per guest. Out of town guests are welcome any day of the week and so are out of town family members. Guest passes may be purchased in a package of five for \$25 with cash or check from the Club House office or a Surf Club manager. There are no restrictions on how many guest pass packages may be purchased; however, regular guest policy guidelines will still be followed, including: two guests per membership per day and guests must be accompanied by a member.
