The Sedalia Country Club is a family-oriented, private community established by a few distinguished Sedalia residents in 1906. The club's rich traditions of excellence, respectfulness, and integrity surround family and community, and we strive to offer the best services and amenities for our members and guests. The challenging golf course, family-friendly pool, and excellent dining facilities are sure to enrich family experiences and treasured friendships for a lifetime of pleasure and cherished memories. Mission Statement

Since 1906, the mission of the Sedalia Country Club has been to provide a high quality golf and social experience for our members, their families, and guests. By providing the best services, amenities, and staff, Sedalia Country Club creates a fun, family-friendly environment.

History

In 1903, the Missouri State Fair Board gave a small group of Sedalia residents the right to build a golf course on the Missouri State Fairgrounds. Nearly two years later, June 3, 1905, the Sedalia Country Club was formed. There were 67 regular members admitted into the Club.

The next year, the Club purchased a block of ground adjoining the Missouri State Fairgrounds on the east and facing Limit Avenue. On March 22, 1906, the Sedalia Country Club became a corporation. A club house was built at a cost of \$4,200, and opened in June 1906. By then, the regular membership had grown to 88.

In 1907, sixty additional acres were purchased and a nine hole golf course was laid out.

While the Club upheld its high standards as a golf club, it was the scene for many social functions, outstanding parties for the members and entertaining honored guests, such as the formal reception and dinner given in honor of President Taft in 1911.

Over the years, the club was remodeled and redecorated several times, adding locker and shower rooms, golf shop, and the construction of a swimming pool.

On May 4, 1977, a massive tornado ripped through Sedalia and destroyed the club house, swimming pool, tennis courts, and other club facilities. In the months that followed, many proposals were offered for the future of the Sedalia Country Club. In July, the membership voted to purchase the Walnut Hills Country Club, and the two clubs merged in the Walnut Hills neighborhood just west of Sedalia on August 22, 1977.



At the time, the Club included the clubhouse, Surf Club, tennis courts, and golf course.

Many renovations have been made at the Club over the years including the restructuring of the pool, the addition of new kitchen facilities, enlarging the dining area, redesigning the golf course, and adding a large, patio area.

One of the more interesting aspects of the Sedalia Country Club is the presence of a small graveyard on the golf course, which has burial markers with dates prior to the Civil War. Located in the rough between the 10th, 11th, and 18th holes, the Shobe-Jamison-Quisenberry Cemetery is the final resting place of members of some of Pettis County's oldest families that were buried between 1859 and 1921.

Hours of Operation

The Sedalia Country Club is open to its members Tuesday through Sunday and closed on Monday. The office is open Tuesday through Friday 8:30 AM to 5:30 PM.

Becky McGinnis is the Clubhouse Manager. Becky oversees the Clubhouse and Surf Club. She has been with the Club since 2011, and knows the Club like the back of her hand. She can assist you with any questions or problems you may have.

Attire

While the Club has no specific dress code other than for the golf course and staff, please use your best judgement in your attire.

Minimums

Each membership classification has a required dining minimum that must be spent each month. Members spending dates are as follows:

A through F	11 th through 10 th
G through N	
O through Z	25 th through the 24 th

The first date is when the minimums will start and the second date is when the cycle ends the following month.

Guests

Guests are almost always welcome to the Club House as long as they are accompanied by a member or meeting with a member of our staff. A dining guest's bill may be applied



against the member's monthly minimum spending. Please note that other areas of SCC have different guest policies.

Dining

The Sedalia Country Club has numerous options available for dining and drinks, including a scenic upstairs lounge, formal and casual dining rooms, private dining room, and patio. Menus change through the seasons, and a kid's menu is always available.

Lunch is served from 11 am to 2 pm, and dinner is served from 6 pm to 9 pm. Reservations are requested for all dining services. To make a reservation, call (660)826-2044.

Most food purchases count toward the monthly minimum. The only exceptions are carryout orders and beverages which do not count against the minimum. A 10 percent gratuity is added to menu prices for your server, as well as a 5 percent house cover.

Bar

Other great assets for SCC are the upper and lower bars. Whether you want to enjoy a few drinks with friends or grab an "adult" refreshment on a hot day of golf, the bar has you covered! The lower bar is opened from 11 am to 6 pm. The upper bar opens at 6 pm and closes when the last member leaves.

Golf Course Hours

The golf course is open Tuesday through Sunday and closed on Monday. On occasion, the course will be open on Monday for special tournaments and events.

A hidden gem in the Midwest, we take pride in our beautiful golf course. It would not be possible without Dallas Baldwin, Adam Pirtle, and their golf course crew. Dallas has been the Golf Course Superintendent at SCC for nearly 40 years and is a member of the Golf Course Superintendent's Association of America.

Golf Shop

Our golf shop offers a wide selection of golf attire and equipment for both men and women. Our courteous staff is ready to assist you!

Jaron Lucchesi is the Head Golf Professional at SCC. As a Sedalia native and employee of SCC since 2005, Jaron can answer all of your golf questions. Noah Kelley is the 1st Assistant Golf Professional. Personable and knowledgeable, Noah is a great asset to the staff.

The Golf Pro Shop hours vary depending on the season. From April to October, the shop is open 8 AM to 7 PM every day, but is closed on Mondays. From November to March, the shop is open 10 AM to dusk on Tuesdays through Fridays and 9 AM to dusk on Saturdays and Sundays.

Attire

Proper golf attire is required on the golf course and practice range at all times.

Driving Range

The driving range hours of operation will fluctuate with the hours of daylight. It will open when the Golf Shop opens and close at dusk. On Sundays the driving range will close 2 hours before dark to clean pick for mowing. Balls will be set-up at all times during the golf season. Members who pay an annual range membership fee to hit unlimited range balls may



do so without coming into the Golf Shop. Those members who do not have a season range membership must come to the Golf Shop and sign a ticket for range balls.

Bag Storage

For member's convenience the Golf Shop can take care of and store your golf clubs. The clubs are set out for play prior to each round and cleaned when you are finished. This service is available for a minimal fee of \$75 annually. Please inquire at the Golf Shop for this service.

Golf Handicaps

Our club offers the GHIN system for calculating your handicap. If you have had a handicap in the past, you are automatically in the system. There is a \$21 fee for an annual handicap which will be billed on your club account. If you have any questions, please call Jaron in the Golf Shop.

Tee Times

Tee times are recommended on weekends, holidays, and days set aside for tournament practice rounds. While tee times are not required, players with tee times are given precedence over those with no reservations. Tee times may be arranged by calling the Golf Shop at (660)826-2230 no more than 2 weeks in advance.

Private Lessons

Private lessons are available for men, women, and juniors. Our golf staff will be happy to schedule your private lessons by calling or coming by the Golf Shop

Junior Golf Program

The Sedalia Country Club golf staff provides a Junior Golf Academy each summer, with instruction covering the golf swing, golf course care, proper etiquette, and rules.. The program also includes competitions and play days. The summer program concludes with an awards pool party. Please pick up a Junior Golf Packet from the Golf Shop.

Golf Outings

If you are considering a company golf tournament or charitable golf event, please get an application from Jaron Lucchesi in the Golf Shop and sumbit requests prior to January 15 for the coming year. All special golf outings are welcome but subject to availability and approval by the Board of Directors.

Guests

Guests are allowed to play the Sedalia Country Club golf course, but must follow all SCC policies and guidelines. Guest fees are:



House/Family Guest	\$25 (18 Holes) \$12.50 (9 Holes)
Accompanied Guest	\$40 (18 Holes) \$25 (9 Holes)
Unaccompanied Guest	\$60 (18 Holes) \$40 (9 Holes)
In-County Guest	\$60 (18 Holes)

Each In-County Guest is restricted to three rounds per year.

All fees include a one hour range session

Any member bringing an allowable guest to play on a Monday must sign a guest fee ticket prior to that day.

Trail Fees

Members who use their own golf carts on the golf course are required to pay an annual "trail fee". This fee is billed in March and must be paid before the cart is permitted on the course. The fee for 2018 is \$350.

Policies and Guidelines

- 1. All guests must be registered with the Golf Shop prior to play.
- 2. All play is to begin on hole #1 unless authorized by the Golf Shop staff.
- 3. Proper golf attire is required on the golf course and practice range at all times.
- 4. Groups are limited to 5 players or less.
- 5. Each player must have a bag and clubs.
- 6. No more than 2 persons and 2 sets of clubs shall ride on a cart unless authorized by the Golf Shop staff.
- 7. Please keep golf cars at least 35 feet from the greens and tees.
- 8. Please observe signage on #1 and #10 tees for the golf cart restrictions for that day.
- 9. Please repair all ball marks on the greens.
- 10. No play is allowed until 1 PM on Monday unless otherwise authorized by the Golf **Professional Staff**
- 11. Tuesday mornings during the golf season are reserved for Ladies. Men may not tee off before 12 noon.

12. Junior Play is regulated by the Golf Professional Staff. Please have your child check in with the staff before he or she plays.

Surf Club

The Surf Club provides member families and thier guests with an enjoyable and relaxing pool environment to cool down on a hot summer day.

Hours and Contact Information

The SCC Surf Club is open 7 days a week from Memorial Day weekend through Labor Day weekend. Typical hours are 11 AM to 7 PM. If inclement weather occurs, the Surf Club may close early at the manager's discretion.

Connie Delph is one of the pool managers, and you can catch her at the pool most any day. Darrin Christian, another manager, takes care of the pool house. The phone number for the Surf Club is (660)826-8424.

Pool Snack Bar and Grill

The Surf Club offers a delicious pool snack bar and grill with the best summer treats. Members have the option of charging food and drinks to their accounts or paying with cash or credit card. However, families with a Surf Club membership may pay with cash or credit card only.

Guests

Mondays are designated guest days. Members may bring guests on Mondays for \$5 per guest. Out of town guests are welcome any day of the week and so are out of town family members. Guest passes may be purchased in a package of five for \$25 with cash or check from the Club House office or a Surf Club manager. There are no restrictions on how many guest pass packages may be purchased; however, regular guest policy guidelines will still be followed, including: two guests per membership per day and guests must be accompanied by a member.
